

Obtaining “Renter’s” Insurance

You are covered by SoaringNV’s insurance when flying with a SoaringNV instructor. However, when renting one of our gliders you are responsible for any damage that you cause. You will need to provide proof of insurance coverage before you can solo a SoaringNV glider. This insurance is to protect you in the event of an incident or accident in which the glider is damaged. Your renter’s insurance covers you for the cost of repairs and lost revenue while the glider is being repaired.

Insurance consists of hull coverage and liability. We ask for at least \$30,000 in hull coverage. The level of liability coverage you choose is up to you. If you don’t currently have renter’s insurance, you can apply online or by fax, and it will usually go through in about 24 hours.

Typical cost is less than \$500 per year. If you own an aircraft you may or may not have coverage for non-owned aircraft, and you should check with your agent.
